

Department 14 - Home, Community or Group Exhibits

Entry Dates: August 17 - 26 (10am - 4pm) & August 27 (10am - 7pm)

The purpose of these exhibits is to present a complete and clear picture of the family, including it's products, farming systems, activities and life. Exhibits will be judged on the basis of the clarity, quality, arrangement and attractiveness.

Placards, miniature models, and other devices may be used as well as products, to show activities.

1.000 Points will be used as a basis of a perfect score and will be divided as follows.

1.) **Home Food Supply**

200 Points

Products will be judged on basis of variety, quality and adequacy. They may include fresh, canned, dried, frozen, or otherwise preserved food, including fruits, vegetables, meats, dairy, poultry, or other food produced and used in the community.

2.) **The Farming System**

200 Points

This will include erosion control, soil improvement, livestock, feed for stock and cash crops. A picture of this part of the community may consist of products, pictures, placards or other means of display to illustrate what is being done.

3.) **Home & Farm Improvements**

200 Points

This improvement phase of the community should show what improvements are made in the home and on the farm to add to the appearance, convenience and comfort of the farm family. Pictures, miniatures, placards and actual equipment may be used to illustrate.

4.) **Community or Group Work**

200 Points

Activities of organized groups should be clearly shown - churches, schools, recreations, 4-H, Clubs, PTA, FFA, Home Demonstration and other organized efforts and accomplishments should be included.

5.) **Arrangement & Appearance**

200 Points

Attractiveness, clarity, neatness and arrangement will be used as a basis for this section.
