Place Setting Exhibit Rules

* Entries can be set up August 17 - 27. Must be set up no later than August 27th 7:00pm. See schedule for hours.

- * This exhibit class is open to adults as well as youth aged 11 and older.
- * Only the person whose name appears on the entry form is allowed in exhibit area during setup.
- * All entries must display one place setting representing the "Celebration Theme". If the theme is not represented, it will not be accepted.
- * Settings must include placemat (or similar), napkin, plates, glassware, cup/saucer and flatware. NO STEAK KNIVES. Other accessories and embellishments are allowed, but must meet size requirements.
- * You have a 14" x 16" space on a farm table to work with. All items must be within those measurements. Items in your space can be no more than 8" tall for any type of center piece.
- * Entries over the maximum size requirements allowed will not be accepted.
- * No fresh flowers, live plants or food items. No disposable place settings, disposable paper tablecloths or paper napkins.
- * Candles, if used, may not be lit.
- * Fair staff will not maintain battery operated accessories. If used, these items will not be replaced if they run out.
- * Although reasonable efforts will be undertaken to safeguard exhibitors' property against loss, damage or theft, the Sevier County Fair will NOT be responsible for any loss, damage or theft of exhibitors' property. We DO NOT recommend bringing anything of great value or sentimental value to exhibit.
- * We have limited space for these exhibits. You must reserve your spot by calling the fair office at 865-453-0770. In addition to reserving your spot you must submit an entry form. This can be done online or at time of entry.
