- 7.) Entries may only be from individual exhibitors, please, no organizations.
- 8.) Hanging Plants MUST be presented hanging.

Department 20 - Floral - Cut Flowers

1.) The Floral Dept. reserves the right to trim stems of cut flowers to better fit the containers.

2.) Multiple stems should be of same variety.

3.) Cut flowers will be exhibited in a Fair provided container with a water solution prepared by Fair Volunteers.

4.) A STEM is a single shoot, twig or branch that bears one flower. A SPRAY bears two or more flowers.
