- 1.) You must be an active 2020 Sevier County Master Gardener in good standing.
- 2.) All entries must be grown & produced by the exhibitor. No recently purchased entries.
- 3.) Plants entered must have no infestation of insects or diseases.
- 4.) Each potted container entry MUST have a saucer or container with water reservoir (NO EXCEPTIONS).
- 5.) No gloss or shine may be added to plant leaves.
- 6.) Exhibits will be judged on plant quality, beauty, and presentation.
- 7.) Any living plant MUST be labeled for educational purposes for our community outreach. You will be provided a label at Master Gardener meetings and/or when you enter your exhibits.
- 8.) Anyone entering an exhibit in at least 3 classes will be awarded a special pin at the 2020 Awards Dinner.

 01 Thriller, filler, spiller

Requirements For Thriller, filler, spiller

- ~ Plants must be in a decorative container
- ~ Must be at least three plants with two or more different species.
- ~ Thriller must be mostly upright, cover the soil & surround the base of the thriller.
- ~ At least some part of the spiller must hang below & outside the top lip of container.
- ~ Must be identified with Latin and variety names.
- ~ Bonsai techniques are allowed with all wires & supports removed prior to entry.
- ~ If more than 25 pounds it must be mounted on a rolling platform.

02 Patio Plant (NEW)
 01 Patio Plant

Requirements For Patio Plant

- ~ Container can be decorative or utilitarian, but cannot be in a thin nursery pot.
- ~ Can be decorative or productive (bears fruit, is edible or fragrant).
- ~ Fruiting plants are not required to be in season.
- ~ Must be identified with Latin and variety names.
- ~ If more than 25 pounds it must be mounted on a rolling platform.

03 Container
 01 Creative Re-Purposed
 Container

Requirements For Creative Re-Purposed Container

- ~ Container must be an item that was intended for a purpose other than planting.
- ~ Container must be used in a different manner than originally intended, such as, but not limited to - wash tubs, boot, bird cage, suit case, etc.
- ~ If container has drainage holes you must have saucer/tray under container.
- ~ Must have at least one living plant.

04 Creative Design
(Open - No Theme)
 01 Creative Design

Requirements For Creative Design

- ~ No larger than 15" x 15" x 15"
- ~ Must contain dried plants, natural plant material and/or plants that require no watering for 9 days such as cacti or succulents.
- ~ Any living plant MUST be labeled for educational purposes for our community outreach. You will be provided a label at Master Gardener meetings and/or when you enter your exhibit.
- ~ Judging will be on creativity, health of plants, appearance, display and design elements.

Requirements For Edible/Medicinal Plants

~ Maximum of 10 lbs.

~ Must be in a presentable container (not just a black plastic flower pot).

~ MUST have a medical use or be edible.

Requirements For Tropical

~ Maximum of 25 lbs.

~ Tropical plant is any vegetation in tropical latitudes. Examples are, but not limited to cactus, orchids, palms, banana, citrus, etc.

Requirements For Windowsill Herb Garden

~ Must contain 3 or more different herbs.

~ Container must be suitable for windowsill no larger than 36".
