All entries must be grown in Sevier County and grown by the exhibitor. Exhibitors may enter only one per lot. Any decaying items will be removed at the discretion of the Committee Chairman. All entries must be free of dirt, diseases, and blemishes. Only exhibits deemed worthy will be awarded a premium. Items left after September 10th will be discarded. **Numbers in parentheses indicates quantities of item to be entered.**
