### Special Floral Considerations

- 1) All entries must be grown by the exhibitor for a period of at least 3 months.
- 2) ALL plants submitted MUST be free from insects and disease.
- 3) Only one exhibit per line item, as listed below.
- 4) No gloss or shine may be added to leaves.
- 5) Make certain your potted plant entries have a saucer or water reservoir.
- 6) Plants will be judged on plant quality, beauty, & presentation by two qualified professionals in Horticulture.
- 7) Entries may only be from the individual participant. No organizations.

**All plants will be watered by a Floral Department Volunteer as needed.**
